"Dr. Radvindranath Reddy, a pediatrician and neonatologist, said medical school never taught him how to share with parents the diagnosis that their child had a disability. But Gianni and other mothers at the playhouse have helped fill that void, he said. Among other things, they visit hospitals to share their birth stories and experiences raising children with Downs syndrome. Their aim is to offer health care professionals the information they need to give parents a more positive take on a child's future. Last Week Reddy congratulated a couple on the birth of their son as he also told them the baby had Down syndrome. "I said everybody had their own potential to develop, and we don't know what he is going to achieve. Be happy and do the best you can." Reddy said."
