sitting there today reading this newsletter a family somewhere is finding strength from our message. Thank you to all of you! Without all of you this message of "hope" would not be able to reach so many people.






Thank you Com Ed and United Way!!

The literacy program- GiGi's Playhouse provides FREE private tutoring to children with Down syndrome. Customized materials are provided for each individual student. The program also assists teachers and parents on how to tutor their children.

"Future" Friday Friends— Ages 6-8 only. Kids create lasting friendships through facilitated interactive play, while promoting good social skills. Each session ends with a pizza dinner in which social skills and table manners will be encouraged.

Fall Birthday Party- If you were born in September, October or November or just love a good party come on by! The birthday child gets a gift and everyone gets a goodie bag.

Reserved– Playhouse may be reserved for private play groups, parties or support groups

The Playhouse can be reserved for any Down syndrome related event. When it is available it may also be used by other groups with special needs.

2 & under playgroup: Families with children 2 and under get together and play while the parents network with each other. Siblings always welcome.

3-5 year old playgroup: Families with children ages 3-5 get together and play while the parents network with each other. Siblings always welcome.

GiGi's Crawlers: This group focus' on crawling skills as well as fine motor skills, social interaction with peers in a semi-structured environment. Children need to be crawling and are accompanied by a parent/adult.

GiGi's Walkers: This group focus' on post walking skills, with their peers, to prepare children for school activities (balance beam, kicking, throwing, jumping, etc). Children need to be walking independently and are accompanied by a parent/adult.

Teen Tastic: This group ususally meets the 4th Fri. of the month from 7-9pm. We order pizza for dinner and have lots of fun watching movies and playing games with each other. 6th-12th grades.

Hispanic Group: Spanish speaking families gather for food, fun, friendship and education.


Intro to Sign Language: Come with your child to learn Sign Language. All ages are welcome.

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Top 10 IDEAS to spread Down syndrome awarerness!

Show the world how proud you are of your child with Down Syndrome!

- Bulletin Board Create one in your child's school or a sibling's school entitled "Just Like You" with pictures of your child interacting with friends, family, classmates, scouts, etc.
- Books Donate to your child's school or local library. Copies may be available at Ups for Downs or purchase from www.amazon.com
 - "We'll Paint the Octopus Red",
 "My Friend Isabelle", "The Best
 Worst Brother" and for siblings
 "Views From Your Shoes" are
 some examples.
- 3. Email Blast Send an email to everyone educating people about DS, your personal story, and some pictures. Include an email to your school district teachers/principals by going to your district website to secure email addresses.
- 4. Librarians Your school district website should have the library/LRC directors email addresses (you may have to go to each school's webiste!). Send them an email and include the names/cover pictures of your favorite books about DS. Ask them to consider ordering them for their library!

- Get Involved! Volunteer at GiGi's Playhouse and/or attend one of the numerous Down syndrome events this month including the DS Support Buddy Walk, Ups for Downs Dinner Dance, NADS Annual Conference or the NADS Fashion Show Luncheon.

Whether it's how far you've come or how far you hope to go, many of us forget to sit down, reflect, and enjoy the moment:) Ask relatives to write about how your child has changed their life and SAVE these for your child. (You could also submit them to the Playhouse to be used for various awareness projects, Website, calendar, newsletter, etc...or submit it to your local support group).

GiGI's Playhouse has many materials to help you. We can provide you with custom activity books and posters (with your child's

picture on them), area support group information, book marks, and other tools for helping you spread the LOVE!
