### **Spreading Awareness to Our Future Educators!**

On Friday, November 19th Nancy and GiGi Gianni were joined by Shari Andress (literacy director at Hoffman Estates), and Natalie and Genia Latka (Plainfield board member and former educator) to give a presentation at Northern Illinois University to graduating special education teachers. What an opportunity!! It was an amazing afternoon of education, awareness and opportunity as they shared how to better serve our kids in school. The presentation helped to showcase all the wonderful things that occur at the Playhouse. Testimonials of the parents we serve were given which showed these future teachers the strength and importance of the Down syndrome community. Shari shared the methodology and success of the Literacy program as GiGi showed off her reading skills! The students were impressed with how many different children we help from ages 2 to

26. Genia shared information about her expectations for Natalie's education. As an educator she also shared ways to

help our children do well in the special education classroom. Natalie's energy was contagious as she ran around and shared her toys with them and played peek-a-boo around the podium!

Many questions were raised about our children and the type of future we expect for them. Our goal was to show these educators our children's potential and to

teach them that the diagnosis of Down syndrome should not limit what our children are taught nor limit the expectations an educator should have for them. The students left excited about teaching children like ours and surprised at how well they do!

Hop, Skip and Jumpers: For 3-5 year olds, this program will help promote friendships, good social skills and interactive play through fun creative activities!

**Hispanic Group:** Spanish speaking families gather for food, fun, friendship and education.

**Polish Play Group:** Polish speaking families gather for an afternoon of fun and friendship.

**Reserved:** Playhouse may be reserved for private play groups, parties or support groups

**GiGi's Crawlers:** This group focuses on crawling skills as well as fine motor skills, social interaction with peers in a semi-structured environment. Children need to be crawling and are accompanied by a parent/adult

**GiGi's Walkers:** This group focuses on post walking skills with peers to prepare children for school activities (balance beam, kicking, throwing, jumping, etc.) Children need to be walking and must be accompanied by a parent/adult.

The Playhouse can be reserved for any Down syndrome related event. When it is available it may also be used by other groups with special needs.

ing a child with Down syndrome. Fortunately, not every child with Down syndrome will go through cancer treatment. However, some of our kids, whether its been a heart surgery, GI problems or any other medical issue, will face some sort of medical obstacle. This is just another common thread we share. When we initially moved here 5 yrs ago, I was sad that we didn't have any family in the area. Since that time I am happy to say that our "family" has grown larger than I ever thought possible. Our "Playhouse family" is one that we will forever cherish and one that will continue to support and accept us through whatever obstacles come our way.

My grandfather was my buddy. Even though he was sick, I was able to make him smile and bring him comfort. In his memory, my family will be giving half of the raised donations in his name to GiGi's Playhouse.

My Grandpa would be proud to know that he was able to support important organizations even after his death! Thanks Grandpa, we miss you!
