Down syndrome and is the light of their lives! Erin is getting ready to learn how to read and her parents are so excited about it that they have started a GiGi's Playhouse Literacy Satellite in Westmont, IL!

In order to raise money for the Satellite, Ryan and Megan decided to throw a birthday party in honor of their sis-

ter with half of the proceeds going towards the Literacy program! So on February 23rd, more than 150 people came out to Arabian Knights, a heated barn full of games and activities, and showed their support for Erin! Diane Compton, mother to these 3 amazing children, says it best herself...

I still can't believe it happened. We started planning 5 weeks ago and when we first visited Arabian Knights, our estimate was 30 people. Then the calls with offers of raffle prizes started coming.

We ended up with 150 people attending. That didn't even count the people that just stopped in to drop off a donation. At this point, we've made close to \$5,000 to be split between GiGi's and Joni and Friends, another

organization that Erin benefits from. As for the highlight of the event, it was seeing so many people willing to come out to support this great cause. Friends came from very far away to lend their support and the entire community rallied around us! Erin enjoyed playing hostess, giving lots of hugs and Megan is already planning her party for next year. She has decided she will not have a birthday party with out GiGi ever again!



GiGi's Walkers: This group focuses on post walking skills with peers to prepare children for school activities (balance beam, kicking, throwing, jumping, etc.) Children need to be walking and must be accompanied by a parent/adult.

The Playhouse can be reserved for any Down syndrome related event.

When it is available it may also be used by other groups with special needs.

5K Run June 8th


We need committee leaders/members for planning the event and approximately 120 volunteers needed the day of the 3.1 mile run. We'll also need sponsors.
