

As Jake comes to the end of his first semester in GiGi's Literacy Program, his tutor, Rachel reflects on her 16 weeks with him...

"I have really enjoyed working with Jake this session. He is always happy to arrive at GiGi's, gets a big smile on his face & dashes in. We started with a custom "family" book & cards we made him, and he is becoming a pro at selecting the correct picture when asked. He likes to watch Barney at home and does very well with the Barney flashcards. We have also been working on colors, using signs, toys & objects around the room as well as the cards. He is doing great at identifying the correct keys on the color-coded piano for me. When it's time to play he's excited to move all around in the open room, use the slide, & play catch."

Hopping, Skipping, and Jumping...

Arguably, the greatest benefit of our programming at GiGi's is that each program overlaps and reinforces other parts of the four main program categories: positive beginnings, therapeutic movement, social skill development and educational programming. A few weeks ago, I was able to participate in a Hop, Skip and Jumpers class. Designed for children ages 3-5, this program employs children in active and engaging themecentered lessons, while developing gross and fine motor skills, muscle tone and educational skill. I watched in delight and amazement for an hour and a half as children three and four years old sang, danced, made art, and learned about the weather, all while reinforcing their knowledge of colors and numbers. It was delightful to watch children sing, dance, and learn a variety of new colors and words- all while having fun, increasing social skills and fostering new and existing friendships.

Hop, Skip and Jumpers is one of the many programs which illustrate what makes the programming at GiGi's first-class: the energy, love and commitment of volunteers, families and the community to a child-centered, far-reaching and cross-categorical education and development- all while having a blast!
