Grace has a way with people. She brightens a room when she walks into

it... When my mother, Dorothy, was diagnosed with lung cancer last September, my first thought was of my children. I was very concerned about how they were going to handle being without her. She was, after all their only living grandparent. But children

are resilient; they bounce back and move on. It's the adults in the family who are left scarred and saddened.

When it became apparent that my mom was not going to beat the cancer and have one of those miraculous "fight the good fight" battles, she stepped up and accepted it. I was still in denial, but she was not. She kept telling me to grab the camera and get some good pictures; she knew time was running out.

On May 4, 2010, she took her last breaths. She was at home, in her bed, with

all her children surrounding her and holding her hands. She was peaceful and beautiful we were all in tears. Each of my children came up and said their goodbyes after she had passed. Gracie came into the room, looked around at all of us, and saw my mom on

the bed. She gave her a pat on the head, a kiss on the cheek, and said "Feel better soon, Teeta" and scampered out of the room. Everyone knew Grace held a special place in my mom's heart and for a very brief second, the sad mood in the room brightened. At Dorothy's memorial her family had gifts sent to GiGi's Playhouse in memory of Grace's Grandma. Thank you to those who donated in her memory.

### The First National'Lemonade Day


