

Making Strides in Literacy!

It's IEP time, and we have heard stories that run the gamut from great experiences to not so great experiences. Here is a recent email we received...

"I was recently pouring over test results and old and new goals as I prepared for Hannah's IEP. IEPs always make me a little nuts as they write out everything our children are not able to do yet.

However I did want to share one part of Hannah's test results. Her reading and word decoding tested at 6 months older than she is. Now keep in mind that was on a typically developing test. So Hannah not only scored well but she scored better than her age!! They highlighted that on the word decoding they gave her word groups that were not real words to see if she would try to sound them out and she did. She knew the sounds and would put them together.

This is all attributed to her Literacy program at GiGi's! Hannah has had wonderful tutors and the program has showed us how to help her at home. I just wanted to say THANK YOU because the program has helped us make great strides!

Changing Perceptions

The Gallery, a 30 foot exhibit with portraits of individuals with Down syndrome featuring quotes in their own words, was displayed at the Willow Creek Community Church in Chicagoland this month. An older man was looking at the Traveling Gallery and smiling. Julie, a friend of the Playhouse, commented, "It's a beautiful display, isn't it?"

"Yes," the man agreed. "Each person is beautiful. I didn't realize so many of their features were so similar."

Julie explained that Down syndrome is a genetic condition and that there are certain characteristics that are common to most individuals with Down syndrome.

The man asked, "Can they learn?"

Julie was taken aback by this question. While her initial response was "of course

they can!", she paused and looked at this man. Clearly, no one had explained to him the abilities of individuals with Down syndrome. Perhaps, he grew up in a generation that didn't believe in the potential of all people with special needs. Julie realized that this conversation was the very reason the Gallery was brought to Willow Creek – to help this man, and the countless others, replace their outdated perceptions with an accurate picture of Down syndrome.

"Yes," she told him, "children with Down syndrome can learn to read, write, drive, work – just about anything you and I can do!"

"Wow, thank you," the man said. "Thank you."

Often, we think we live in a world where acceptance is the norm. Unfortunately, that is not always the case. Our mission is still as needed as ever and GiGi's is here to help you create that awareness and acceptance in your community as well as across the world. On May 15, GiGi's Playhouse hosted the feuding houses of Verona – the Capulets and Montagues – for an hour of Shakespeare scene-stealing. Culminating a six-month study, Chicago's teen drama club performed their several scenes to a packed house at the Menomonee Club's Drucker Center (who generously donated their space for the evening.)

The rehearsal process was vigorous. During the month of February, the group pantomimed several scenes, rotating parts amongst the group so they could all learn the story. After uncovering the four character types in the play (lovers, fighters, rulers and confidants), the group also played several improve-based games to discover how they'd move and talk. Guest artists helped the kids learn the play's prologue in sign language and basic stage sword-fighting (a hit with the boys in the group).

After weeks of practice, both at the Playhouse and at home, the performance was on. In an hour-long performance (using an abridged script adapted by Kathryn Yohe and children's author Bruce Coville), the teens played the parts as well as Olivier. Our warmest thanks to our Drama Club volunteers Katie Yohe and Mallory Schuh and all the kids and their parents for devoting their time and energy to a great evening!

Cruising Crawlers & Walkers....

Yvonne Maniates says, her daughter Ava, who turns three in July, regularly attends the monthly Crawlers & Walkers Class. This class helps infants and toddlers with their fine and gross motor skills. We have two very knowledgeable and experienced therapists who run the class, Val Schmidt, a licensed Occupational Therapist and Lisa Henning, a licensed Physical Therapist. Combined they offer an invaluable service. They both lead busy lives but they give of their time to help our kids.

Ava took her first step at 18 months and with the help of the regular monthly therapy she receives at the Playhouse, she is making remarkable progress! Val is currently working with Ava on fine tuning her scissor skills. Lisa is helping Ava walk downstairs plus walk sideways with the aid of a balance beam.

We encourage everyone with a young child regardless where they are in their developmental stage to come to the Crawlers & Walkers Class held every second Saturday at 10:15 am at the McHenry Playhouse.

"After the sessions, I was enthusiastic about trying the techniques at home and in every day life with my son and we're already seeing the benefits in his understanding of math and in his school work! His favorite techniques are M&M charting and pizza fractions."

Genia Latka, Math Program Director, explains that math truly can be something fun to incorporate throughout your child's day and gears her training sessions to have parents and tutors alike feel comfortable teaching the methods. "Our goal is to be a resource for the parents and schools so they can make modifications or adaptations to their existing math program to best suit each student." Latka explains that the program reaches beyond the one-on-one tutoring GiGi's offers, and is a method that incorporates math learning in real-life experiences, "Parents are their child's best teacher!"
