What an Honor!

GiGi's Playhouse is proud to share that we were honored with the National Parent Group Award at the National Down Syndrome Congress Annual Convention in San Antonio, TX last month! This prestigious award is presented to organizations that contribute to spreading positive and accurate awareness of Down syndrome throughout the nation. Nancy Gianni accepted the award on behalf of all our Playhouses nationwide and those up and coming. Here is an excerpt from her speech that night.

"I want to thank the board members, families, staff, volunteers and donors from around the world who make the Playhouses possible. Together we are changing the way the world sees Down syndrome which will make a difference not only in my daughter's life but in the lives of all children with Down syndrome!"

The next morning, GiGi's presented a workshop entitled The Power of Empowerment. With over 100 people in attendance, we spoke to new parents, parents of adults, educators, therapists and community members about how raising expectations of individuals with Down syndrome can empower parents, individuals with Down syndrome and the local community. We see this empowerment every day at the Playhouse! As a child walks out of the literacy room proud of her reading skills, or when a teen steps onto our stage to sing karaoke with pride, or when our siblings talk to their friends about how proud they are of their brother/sister with Down syndrome - these are all because of being empowered!

At GiGi's Playhouse we focus on the idea that belief in your child's potential can turn into action in your home and community. The end result is a home, school system, and community that upholds the high expectations you have for your child/adult.

Being empowered is a process - everything you do is a step in the right direction towards empowering yourself, your child and your community! The programs at GiGi's Playhouses are designed to help each member of the family and the community raise expectations of all individuals with Down syndrome!
