The Learner with Down syndrome Seminar

On July 8, Shari Andress, a Volunteer from the National GiGi's Playhouse in Chicago & Literacy & Math Trainer came to our Playhouse to give a seminar and series of training programs. The first 60 minutes were spent discussing "The Learner with Down syndrome" with over 20 people in attendance. During this presentation Shari explained new ideas on how to teach peers about what our children can do and how much more alike they are to everyone in the classroom than different. She re-enforced ideas of how to help our kids learn at a rate that is comfortable and successful for them. Since our children are literal learners we need to practice transferring knowledge to their memories through different avenues. The more a person with Down syndrome sees a word or number in different texts and venues the better. Many people shared success stories of their children and students. The purpose of "The Learner with Down syndrome" is to remind us that we can "Expect Our Children to Learn"! 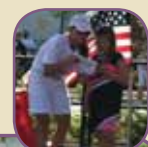

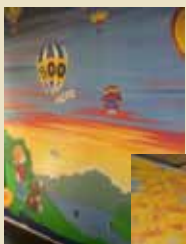


Therapeutic Play Center Art Work
