Breaking news! Today we signed our new lease and begin breaking ground on our future! OK, this is breaking news

to you but as I write this to you today I have the same feeling I had 10 years ago. The same pit in my stomach I had when I signed my first lease and opened the first GiGi's Playhouse. I remember praying that people, besides my Mom, would show up to our opening and understand what I was trying to do. I will never forget opening our doors and seeing hundreds of people lining up to see the first GiGi's Playhouse Down Syndrome Awareness Center!! Well now, 10 years later (and 15 Playhouses later), here I am again with the same fear and pit in my stomach as we embark upon a new adventure.

Expanding on ten years of service to thousands of families nationwide, GiGi's Playhouse will expand its free educational and therapeutic programs by opening a new GiGi's National Achievement Center on October 20, 2013. Located in Hoffman Estates, IL, the 10,000 square foot complex will house the National Playhouse (formerly the Hoffman Playhouse but bigger and better) and a training center for up and coming playhouses! It will also offer a comprehensive new program called "GiGi University": the very first progressive learning center for adults with Down syndrome. A unique component of GiGi University will be an active training business called "Hugs & Mugs". This creative endeavor will offer chocolate & bakery treats in mugs designed with artwork created by the adults themselves as well as kids participating in GiGi's Playhouse. The adults will run the business as an internship, and the retail store front will display additional artwork created by individuals with Down syndrome from around the world.

We have the attention of the country, no, the world! People are changing the way they see our children and adults with Down syndrome and now we need to start opening doors for them!

GiGi's Playhouse is growing by leaps and bounds! We now have 13 Playhouses scattered across 5 states from Georgia to Minnesota and from New York to Iowa. In the next

12 months, we will be growing by more than 50% with 7 new locations opening in 4 new states — Tennessee, Texas, Indiana, Wisconsin and our first international location in Mexico!

NEW PARENT'S PERSPECT



With a little help from Mom and Dad, Lucas crossed the finish line at this years 5k!

Our family and friends helped us through the diagnosis but it was learning about this wonderful place called GiGi's Playhouse over the internet that really represented the true meaning of hope for us. We scoured every link of their website and before I could even comprehend what was happening my husband and I were signed up for our first GiGi's walk in the summer of 2011, when I was six months pregnant. There I was on this hot humid day, a pregnant woman expecting a child with Down syndrome at a Down syndrome event and

terrified in my own skin. Even though we knew about Down syndrome, we didn't really know much and didn't know anyone with an extra chromosome; but being at this event made everything real. I remember thinking as I was registering that there was

still time to leave and maybe I made a big mistake by coming to the walk. For heavens sake, I was a big hormonal pregnant woman who was not thinking clearly half of the time. I remember feeling like everyone was staring at me even as I tried to hide the

stinging, crying eyes behind my big sunglasses. What started out as a very tough day with lots of tears turned into a magical experience with tears of hope and happiness. For the first time I was relieved at what I saw that day. I saw love, I saw support, I saw family, I saw happiness, I saw a sense of belonging, I saw beautiful children and I saw what an amazing life my baby Lucas would have.

That day was a game changer for us. It was what we needed to be the best parents we could for Lucas and we haven't stopped yet. Lucas is now a year and a half and the GiGi's walk is an annual family event that everyone looks forward to.

My husband and I often talk about "our first walk;" we chat about how far we have come and it all started with just a little hope.



Before, during and after Kaytlin's health problems GiGi's was there for us every step of the way. I don't know what we would have done without the continuous love and support from GiGi's. Positive energy flows through the doors and windows of the Playhouse like a happy addiction. We are so very thankful for GiGi's

EDUCATION PROVIDES A VOICE



Steven is 22 years old and excelling in the GiGi's Literacy Program.

Steven began his involvement in the Literacy Tutoring Program at the Des Moines Playhouse this past winter and has quickly progressed. In

just 5 months, he increased his comprehension through weekly sessions with his tutor. He tackles challenges with sight words and sounds out complex words with accuracy and enthusiasm. Steven brings his sense of humor to his weekly tutoring sessions and has made learning to read so much fun! He's starting his first novel as we write this newsletter and might be done soon!!!

At Playhouses across the country, children, teens and adults like Steven are learning to read, increasing reading fluency and comprehension every day in one-on-one tutoring sessions, tailored to the individual learner. The Literacy Tutoring program is a supplement to a basal reading programs taught in school, using key concepts of matching, selecting and naming to teach the whole word, alphabet and phonics.

GiGi's Playhouse is so proud of each student, tutor and parent for their determination. Through that determination, our learners develop an invaluable sense of self-esteem that only comes with hard work and achievement.

GiGi's Playhouse Literacy Tutoring and Math Tutoring programs begin at age 3. For more information, to register or learn how to get involved, contact your local Playhouse.

Today, a dream is becoming reality as we introduce GiGi University, a progressive learning program for adults with Down syndrome (22 and older).

GiGi U is a launching pad for achievement! GiGi University is an engaging 8 week instructional program focused in development of confidence, health and the "whole self", followed by an 11-17 week internship opportunity to learn and practice career skills, while gaining crucial work experience.

The 8 week instructional program meets three days per week for four hours. Participants will set goals to improve their self-esteem, self-advocacy and self-care, nutrition, fitness, and safety; as well as career skills, organization and hobbies through their involvement in GiGi University. GiGi U is intended for goal-directed adults who are ready to make a commitment to themselves to walk tall and achieve their greatest potential.

Like all GiGi's Playhouse programs, GiGi U is free to all families and supported through the tremendous contributions of volunteers. As our dream comes to reality, we will share the successes and work to expand this model to other Playhouses. GiGi U will be accepting its inaugural class this fall, at the National Playhouse in Hoffman Estates, Illinois.
