## 191 New Families visit GiGi's Playhouse locations this spring!

Every day, new families walk in the doors of GiGi's Playhouse locations across the country- some new families have just received a prenatal diagnosis, some are parents of a newborn and still others may have an older child or even adult child with Down syndrome and are visiting GiGi's for the first time.

This spring, **191 new families** made that first visit and have taken the first steps to **face the diagnosis** with the support of GiGi's Playhouse.

Most new parents can attest to the fear and anxiety that surrounds their first visit, but as soon as most parents walk through the door and feel the positivity, the fear and anxiety soon passes and are replaced with feelings of **support and a brighter outlook.** Here is one family's view on their first visit to GiGi's Playhouse New York as expectant parents attending the New Parents Group:

"It was so wonderful to meet so many great parents and wonderful babies!! I had no idea about any of this ... so while a little overwhelming, we were glad to start getting all these terms in our heads. Also, so glad that there's a great network of parents to help us navigate. Overall I am feeling much better about things. Meeting people rather than getting lost in my head with worries was such a relief. I can't wait to get to know other families and introduce our little girl into this community.
