## A Word from our Executive Director

Dear Friends of GiGi's,

Is it just me, or did 2021 feel more like an extension of 2020 than a new year? It was difficult to foresee just how significantly the COVID-19 pandemic would continue to plague our community throughout the year, and the ups and downs sometimes felt like a rollercoaster. With the health and safety of our participants and volunteers at the top of our priority list, GiGi's once again had to continually pivot and adapt to continue living out our mission to change the way the world sees Down syndrome.

**But 2021 at GiGi's was much more than just "getting by."** Through a combination of careful inperson programs and virtual offerings, we increased the number of program hours when families were participating at GiGi's by 14% over 2020's participation. We piloted a brand-new career preparation program for adults called GiGi Prep, teaching critical life and job skills for adults. And thanks to our new partners at The Sumner Center at NorthField Church, we opened our very first brick-and-mortar satellite location in Gallatin to serve families in the northeastern suburbs of Nashville. It was a year of growth, impact, and dreams becoming reality.

These therapeutic and educational programs were led by hundreds of volunteers who graciously gave of their time and talents to support individuals with Down syndrome and their families. Community partners like universities, churches, and other nonprofit organizations rallied with us to extend our reach farther than we could ever do alone. And the individuals, companies, and foundations who generously supported our organization financially ensured that our services do not cost a penny for the families that we serve, not now and not ever.

In fact, that's my favorite part about the GiGi's community: we exist only because the middle Tennessee community has collectively decided to stand together alongside our friends with Down syndrome to declare that their lives are deserving of celebration and that they are more than worthy of our support and advocacy.

So on behalf of all of the individuals and families who call GiGi's a home away from home, **thank you.** We are stronger together, and the best is yet to come!



# New Satellite Location: Sumner County

In spite of the COVID-19 pandemic continuing to impact our community, a long-term dream for GiGi's came to fruition in January of 2021: we launched our first official satellite campus for GiGi's Nashville.

Thanks to the gracious partnership of NorthField Church, GiGi's now has a long-term home in Gallatin located at The Sumner Center, a new community center that houses multiple community resources. Out of this space, we have new



opportunities to provide free, accessible, and meaningful programming to those who live north and northeast of Nashville—a group that previously had major geographic barriers to participating regularly at our Brentwood facility.

Throughout 2021, we piloted a variety of group programming for all ages as well as math and literacy tutoring, and we are thrilled to continue growing our footprint in the area to serve more families than ever before.



# Because of you... Stories Like Destiny's



"Destiny was 10 months old when we found out that she has Down syndrome. It was a very emotional and confusing time for my husband and me. There were no groups for parents or other resources to help us better understand what we needed to know about having a child with Down syndrome. There was nothing like GiGi's to share resources, help, or therapeutic support. I felt lost and concerned about Destiny's future. Would she be able to do all the things her sister was doing? Will she go to college, get married, etc.?"

"After growing up in Virginia, Tennessee, and Colorado, Destiny graduated from high school in 2019, and we moved back to the Nashville area. One of the first things I did was get reconnected with the Down Syndrome community. Destiny and I met a group of wonderful ladies whose adult children have been a part of GiGi's Playhouse for years. They quickly let me know that GiGi's has resources for all ages, and they invited us to attend the E.P.I.C. program (Empowerment, Participation, Independence, & Community Involvement). Destiny really enjoyed it and we've been a part of GiGi's ever since!"

"There are not many organizations that offer programs for adults with Down syndrome—programs that help our children learn and grow to be independent. Other organizations require you to pay a large fee for your child to participate. NOT GiGi's! I inquired about the fee when I was registering Destiny for the first class, and I was told they offer their programs to families for free. We've participated in various programs in many different states, and only a handful were provided for free."

"Destiny has now participated in several programs at GiGi's. These programs will help her to be successful and, one day, be fully independent. To know that she can come here, make friends, have fun, do what she loves, learn life skills, be loved, AND be safe... what more can a parent ask for? Words cannot express how thankful we are for every person who has either volunteered, taught a class, given a donation, or supported GiGi's in some way. Know that because of you, your donations, support and love, our daughter will one day be able to live on her own due in part to what she has learned here at GiGi's."
