things would not be as fun as they are now in our house. I thank God everyday that I had a sister with Down syndrome and it didn't ruin my life; it made it better.

#### Bella 2nd grade — 8 years old

My sister GiGi has so many talents. Like gymnastics, because she is an awesome gymnast. She is a very active girl. She always has something on her mind. She does a lot of things I did when I was little. I am not afraid of Down syndrome because I know GiGi and she can do anything that we do. Sometimes we help her but she never gives up. She is supposed to have muscles that don't work like mine but she is really strong and she is my best friend.


#### 1st Annual Doubles Bag Toss Tournament
