## **Proud of Our Reader**

Some people think that our Literacy program is only for children. Wait until you read this story!!

Lisa came to our Literacy Program in January with the reading ability of a preschooler. She knew a few words, recognized her name and had a stubborn desire to learn more. She is 35 years old.

We started out much like I did with my other students, with beginning level books. When I pushed her past what I thought was her limit, and asked her if it was too difficult she would say, "I like easy and I like hard. I like them both." There was no technique or new reading game she wouldn't try. She would work for an hour solid without batting an eye so I was kept on my toes coming up with things for her to do! By the third session, Lisa was READ-ING! Two sessions ago, she read a book to me without any help and with full comprehension. When the story was funny, she laughed. She's reading and enjoying what she reads!

The GiGi's literacy program is not only helping kids learn to read but also providing the opportunity for

adults that might not have been taught how to read when they were younger. As this story shows, a 35-year-old with Down syndrome is perfectly capable of learning how to read, and more importantly, NEEDS to learn and DESERVES to learn. She knows what she is capable of and it is far greater than what people see, what even I can see. So I'll keep bringing the books and the flashcards, but I'll let her show me what she can do because as soon as I think I've put my finger on her limits, she just surprises me again and again.

Here is another example of how the Playhouse helps everyone reach their potential!

I started coming to Open Play when Max was about 5 months old. I remember feeling so nervous to walk in by myself and then felt part of an instant family. It was a place where I felt welcome and Max was celebrated.

I was hooked after one day :)! Max loves going there too; he acts as if he owns the place when he walks in.

I love the 5K because it is such a celebratory day. It is fun and is something that people of all ages can participate in. Our friends and family have seen how much we all benefit from GiGi's Playhouse and want to support the cause. 


### Spring Spectacular!


