## Spreading Awareness in the Community

Chris Newlon, Rebecca's mom, was invited to participate in the McHenry High School's Diversity Program. She spent a day with eight Freshmen Health classes talking about Down syndrome and children with special needs. The Diversity program's goal is to get students to accept differences in people, to not pick on others because they are different, but to celebrate each other for who they are.

She spoke about her choice to keep her baby, and about the lives of people with Down syndrome. Chris

addressed some of the differences a child with Down syndrome has, such as low muscle tone and speech. The students asked sincere questions and listened eagerly. One of the students responded "wouldn't our world be a better place if we were all like that!" Chris reports that many were touched by how much they just didn't know about Down syndrome and many asked about volunteering at the Playhouse to learn more and help out. She was invited back for teaching another lesson in the fall semester!

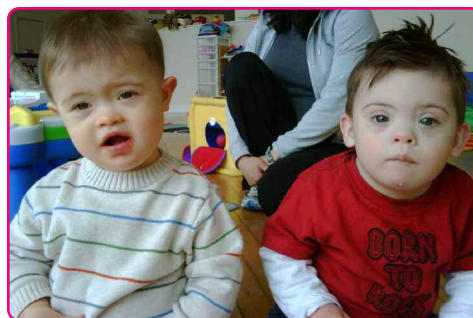
## GiGi's Playhouse Chicago Open Design Event
