

GiGi's Playhouse-Sioux City Achievement Center: Naming Opportunities

All naming opportunities will be prominently displayed in each program area, on the "Miracle Makers" Sioux City Donor Wall, and on the corresponding donor page on GiGi's Playhouse-Sioux City web site.

1. GiGi University Training Room: \$16,000 permanent/\$3,200 annual

IMPACT: Adults gain important personal care, self-advocacy, nutrition and confidence skills that can lead to great achievements and independence.

2. Get Fit Gym: \$30,000 permanent/\$6,000 annual

IMPACT: Adults and kids enhance their physical fitness, muscle tone, self-esteem, self-expression, and socialization skills.

3. Sound Stage: \$16,000 permanent/\$3,200 annual

IMPACT: Adults and kids build greater self-confidence, self-expression, and creativity skills while interacting with peers and siblings.

4. Therapeutic Playground: \$27,000 permanent/\$5,400 annual

IMPACT: Kids improve gross motor skills, language skills and social skills while interacting with peers and siblings.

5. Learning Labs (tutoring rooms): \$8,000 each, permanent

IMPACT: Kids and adults expand their reading skills, math skills, organizational skills, self-confidence, and focus.

6. Studio G: \$16,000 permanent/\$3,200 annual

IMPACT: Artistic activities are a form of occupational therapy and self-confidence building, too! Fine motor skills are developed.

7. Kitchen: \$16,000 permanent/\$3,200 annual

IMPACT: Teenagers and adults learn independent skills to keep them healthy and safe. Proper mealtime routines and age-appropriate use of utensils, napkins and manners are encouraged!

8. Library & Family Resource Center: \$5,000 permanent

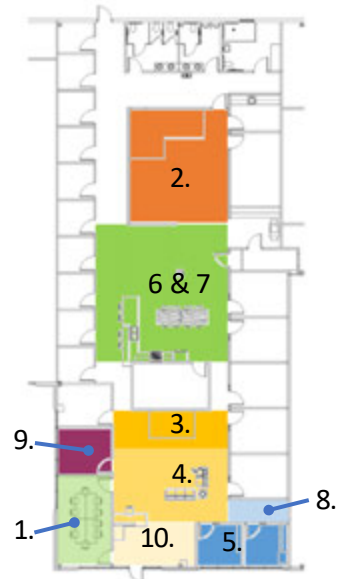
IMPACT: Parents will gain important insights into GiGi's Playhouse programs and Kids and adults will learn to read!

9. Club GiGi: \$9,000 permanent

IMPACT: Building confidence with peers in the Playhouse encourages greater socialization and independence outside the Playhouse
