

Down syndrome (also referred to as 'Trisomy 21') results from a third copy of the 21st chromosome and is the most frequently occurring chromosomal disorder.

Down syndrome occurs in about 1 out of every 691 births.

In the 1950's, the life expectancy of someone with Down syndrome was 12 years old. Today, it is over 60 years of age thanks to medical advances and places like GiGi's Playhouse that help individuals lead more enriched and fulfilling lives!

We want to level the playing field, not just for individuals with Down syndrome, but for people of all abilities!




