



With programs that range from a prenatal diagnosis all the way through adulthood, GiGi's Indy is proud to provide a lifetime commitment to those we serve. Your support this evening means the world to us! As a 501c3 nonprofit organization, we rely entirely on donations from generous individuals who believe in what we do and want to be a part of it too. 
