GIGI'S MADISON HIGHLIGHTS

GiGi's Playhouse Madison closed our physical doors to the public once COVID-19 hit our area in March of 2020. Two weeks later, GiGi's Playhouse, as a National organization, pivoted to virtual programming via GiGi's at Home.

With the work of our National office, Board of Directors, and Site Manager, we were able to continue providing free educational and therapeutic programming for the entire year.



Working as a team, we provided GiGi's At Home virtual programming. Being 99% volunteer run, our amazing volunteers ensured that our families received virtual 1-on-1 literacy tutoring and a wide variety of fitness, educational, therapeutic, & social group programs.



Even though we were 100% virtual for over 80% of the year, our Madison Playhouse was in the top 5 (out of 60) for volunteer hours. We offered 1-on-1 Literacy tutoring to a record number of students, with a record number of tutors!
