On Boarding Process:

- Submit application and resume.
- Meet with Board President or VP to review responsibilities.
- Tour the Playhouse, observe a program and attend a board meeting as a guest.
- After a board vote, our Executive Director will work with you to assign training, submit a background check, sign required documents ensure you're set up in Teams and our website.
