Including affected parents and siblings, over 2 million people are impacted by this diagnosis every single day. Across our network, we provide FREE, life-changing therapeutic, educational, and career training programs for 30.000+ individuals of all ages.

### GiGi's Playhouse Nashville

GiGi's Playhouse Nashville opened its doors in November 2013. It is a physical place where people can connect, meet, and be accepted just as they are. We support individuals with Down syndrome and their families through free programming tailored to their learning style. We encourage participants to give their best effort, and we always celebrate individual progressions and achievements. We are tremendously proud of how far we've come in only 8 years—and we've got even bigger dreams for our future.

# Gloria & Cindy Knoch Award

The Gloria & Cindy Knoch Volunteer Spirit Award honors our founding benefactors
Gloria Knoch, her daughter Cindy, and the entire Knoch family.

Gloria Knoch raised eight children—one of whom was Cindy, born in 1953 with Down syndrome. In 1953, there were very few, if any, resources for children with Down syndrome. Doctors recommended that Gloria institutionalize Cindy. Instead, Gloria and her husband brought Cindy home and into their loving family. Despite the lack of resources for her child, Gloria was a pioneer and began a reading group for children with Down syndrome in her home. The family was not wealthy; despite that, Gloria managed to set aside money for Cindy's future. Sadly, Cindy passed away before Gloria. Upon Gloria's passing, her family wanted to do something that would honor their mother's courage and commitment to supporting and educating her daughter.

The family chose to honor their mother's legacy by giving to the newly opened GiGi's Playhouse Nashville. They recognized that our organization strives to help individuals with Down syndrome achieve to their fullest potential, which is everything that Gloria wanted for Cindy.

The Gloria & Cindy Knoch Volunteer Spirit Award embodies Gloria's giving spirit and her belief that her daughter Cindy could achieve great things if she was given access to the tools and encouragement she needed in order to be successful.

We are pleased to award it to the volunteer of the year for GiGi's Playhouse Nashville, whose giving spirit has greatly impacted our participants.

# Volunteer Spotlight: Kaitlyn Russell



Kaitlyn Russell first started volunteering with GiGi's Nashville back in 2016. By day Kaitlyn works as a legal assistant with Baker Donelson but at GiGi's she is a CrossFit leader extraordinaire. She is always looking for ways to help our GiGi's athletes improve while leading our CrossFit program twice a month.

After COVID hit in 2020, GiGi's Nashville quickly moved to virtual programming. Kaitlyn single handedly organized the CrossFit volunteers to create and implement weekly recorded video workouts so that the participants would still be able to work out at home. This allowed them to stay active and learn how to use items in their home for daily workouts as well.

For many years, Kaitlyn and our CrossFit volunteers have organized the Row-For-A-Reason fundraiser. Kaitlyn helps train GiGi athletes for the event and organizes teams to help raise funds for GiGi's Playhouse Nashville. She has also volunteered at events such as our Trunk-Or-Treat and GiGiFit Acceptance Challenge.



Fellow volunteer and friend, Cody Edwards says of Kaitlyn: "She is one of the most generous people I know and is always thinking of how to put others before herself. She loves GiGi's and makes it a priority in her life, and it shows because the love that is returned from all of the GiGi's athletes!"

Kaitlyn's heart for our participants is contagious and she truly wants each participant to achieve their "best of all". Her commitment to GiGi's Nashville and her positive can-do attitude are a blessing to the staff and we are so grateful for her dedication to GiGi's Nashville!



# Community Partner Award: Belmont University



One of the ways that GiGi's keeps our programs free for families is through the time and talents of hundreds of volunteers who support our work each year. Local teachers, therapists, students, and community members of all backgrounds regularly invest in the GiGi's mission through program leadership, tutoring, administrative support, event planning, and more, and it makes everything we do possible.

When it comes to this vital task of volunteer recruitment and support, one community partner has gone above and beyond for many years now: Belmont University.

With service learning as one of the pillars of its educational model and student experience, Belmont has continually connected countless students to the GiGi's mission. Every spring, Capstone students from the Doctoral Program in Occupational Therapy spend 40 hours a leading core week GiGi's programs such as GiGi Prep and GiGi University, while also



providing invaluable back-end support to other initiatives. In the spring and fall, students from the Music Therapy Program serve GiGi's participants of all ages through the

always-popular Music in Motion class. And students from many different degree programs regularly provide support to our programs after learning about GiGi's through Belmont's "Get Connected" platform.

In past years, Belmont fashion design students at the O'More College of Architecture & Design have teamed up with GiGi's participants as models in their spring fashion show—offering our participants the unique experience of walking the runway while training Belmont students to focus on inclusive design. News of this partnership went viral, spreading the GiGi's mission of empowerment and acceptance across the globe!


