GiGi's Playhouse Programs

A total of 78 individuals with Down syndrome and 80 of their family members participated in 1,707 program hours at GiGi's NOLA in 2023!

Below we highlight new programs that have launched since our last annual report.

Achievers

The GiGi's Achievers program is a new program that empowers adults with Down syndrome with purposeful activities to ensure continued learning and fulfillment of life. This program teaches and promotes communication, self-awareness, independence, health and wellness through community engagement. Each lesson provides participants with "hands on" learning experiences in a naturally occurring environment.

Leaps & Bounds

Leaps & Bounds is a play-based program for young children that focuses on success in preschool and kindergarten. Children practice fun and engaging activities that provide opportunities for following routines, small group participation, movement, and interaction with their environment. Family members are key participants in this program and encourage their child to reach his or her Best of All throughout each session.

GiGi's Kitchen

The GiGi's Kitchen program is designed to emphasize the importance of a healthy lifestyle and provide early exposure to practical cooking skills. Participants engage in activities designed to promote healthy eating habits, kitchen safety awareness, food preparation skills, self-confidence, and social skills by applying learned skills as they prepare and enjoy a shared meal or snack!





TeenTastic

During the summer of 2023, GiGi's Playhouse New Orleans launched TeenTastic which focuses on building social skills with friends with and without Down syndrome by participating in teambased activities in a casual and fun setting. Skill development includes understanding compromise, turn-taking and problem-solving abilities.

One-on-One Math Tutoring

GiGi's Playhouse New Orleans piloted and launched the One-on-One Math Tutoring program during 2022-2023! Building math skills for individuals with Down syndrome increases independence in their school, in the community, and in the workplace. The aim of this program is to help promote a positive experience of learning mathematics with a sound foundation of basic number understanding. Trained tutors work at the level of the learners, continually challenging and encouraging them to reach their Best of All.
